- II. President Farahi addresses UPC
 - Read draft- very well done, consistent with what we have discussed
 - Will review deadlines based on constraints
 - Pieces are appropriate and consistent
 - Gives a blueprint to follow
 - Plans are dynamic with minor changes made here and there
 - President extremely grateful for work done
 - Three general statements: 1) State contributions to University will not increase in the foreseeable future-pattern consistently negative 2) we need to think about how we do business and make a fundamental change in our perspective. The first time full time freshmen are the future of the University. On line systems becoming prevalent and going after the same students as we are (delayed entry- worked first) by 2020 on line is expected to be close to 50% of higher

education offerings. We must educate students in a qualitatively superior way- directly from high school. Then move them to graduate programs- providing an all-inclusive educational experience. 3) There is a serious imbalance in resource allocation. Imbalance in skill level of instructional staff (pedagogy and technology)

- All faculty, staff, adjuncts will have the opportunity to improve their skills
- Review of power point presentation
- Will eliminate programs that don't show growth over 5 year period
- Growth in NJ will be in the western part of the state
- UPC to take more active role in assessment of management, academic affairs, operations
- Globalize every aspect of the curriculum
