## **Kean University Academic Appeals Process**

This process (<u>reinstatement</u>) will apply to students who have been <u>dismissed</u> from Kean University for academic reasons (GPA staying below 2.0 for 2 or more semesters). If you were <u>not dismissed</u> and you have not attended Kean for more than 1 year, then you are seeking <u>Readmission</u> through the Office of Student Success and Retention. This application can be accessed through kean.edu/readmission. <u>Continue for REINSTATEMENT for spring 2019 ONLY:</u>

- 1. Draft a detailed letter stating your reason(s) for poor performance while you were a registered student at Kean University. <a href="Example">Example</a>: If reason(s) is /are medical, please attach documentation to support your case. Be sure that this documentation contains <a href="Edates">dates</a> that correspond with the semesters in question. Address letter to: <a href="Edates">Academic Appeals Committee</a>.
- 2. If you attended another school in your absence, please attach an official transcript from that institution.
- The letter to the committee should also outline your plans for improving your academic performance, if you are allowed to return to Kean University.
- 4. Please include current address, cell number, email address, and Kean ID#.
- 5. Indicate in your letter the **MAJOR** you will be pursuing upon your return
