Students must submit an application to the School of Psychology in order to become “Declared Majors.” Eligibility requires the following: a) At least 40 credits earned before admission date; b) 2.5 overall GPA; c) 3.0 GPA in Psychology and Psychiatric Rehabilitation classes; d) Completed at least 9 credits of Psychology classes before admission date.
