- □ An interview with a member of the department, either in the exit interview for EC 2900 or, in the case of transfer students, by a Department Chairperson or designee;
- □ A minimum grade of "C" in COMM 1402: Speech Communication;
- □ A minimum grade of "C" in ENG 1030: Composition;
- □ A minimum grade of "C" in at least one college-level math course;
- □ A minimum grade of "C" in BIO 1000:Biology;
- □ A minimum grade of "C" in GE 2022: Research & Technology;
- □ Satisfactory completion (with a grade of "C" or better) of Introductory Field, EC 2900: Field Experiences in Multi-cultural Early Childhood Settings or, in the case of transfer students, an equivalent experience.
