# I. General Business

- Special visitors from the Wenzhou campus were introduced by Mr. Philip Connelly to the committee
  - i. Holger Henke (Associate VP for Academic Affairs for the Wenzhou campus)
  - ii. Charles Greenberg (Librarian for Wenzhou campus)

## II. Discussion with Dr. Farahi

- Dr. Farahi gave the committee an update on several initiatives as well as feedback to us regarding the closing the loop activity.

  Among the things that were discussed included:
  - i. Dr. Farahi reviewed the recommendations for funding that he is suggesting to the Board of Trustees. He stated that the overall process of requesting and reporting needs to be cleaned up and that there should be more detail provided for some of the requests. There were some inconsistencies that needed to be cleaned up (See attached sheet for his recommendations).
  - ii. We will have another \$100,000 for a QFI award this year. The money will go toward academic initiatives in 4 specific areas.
    - 1. Globalizing curriculum in academic programs
    - 2. Improving student advisement
    - 3. Student retention initiatives

- 4. Creation of new programs that make us competitive in the marketplace
- iii. Student Retention (one of the 4 areas of the QFI) is very important as the university faces an increasingly competitive marketplace. Finances are restricted and university cannot raise tuition more than 3% annually, therefore retention becomes important as we have to find a way to keep the students we have. Dr. Farahi stressed that the future must be in quality programs and in giving students a complete experience.
- iv. 4 year graduation rate must be improved, the 6 year graduation rate must exceed 50% and it is up to departments to get their BA programs as close to 120 credits as possible.
- v. Effort is being made to get every building (starting with CAS and EC) up-to-date with technology and will provide updated service (including extended hours).
- vi. Advisement concerns are on-going with plans to have all faculty members to advise equal number of students.
- vii. Wenzhou is developing quickly with close to 900 students enrolled. Important for everyone on both campuses to collaborate together moving forward.

## III. Other issues

- Possibility of including WKU staff into follow-up meetings was discussed. Recommendation was made to have meeting in Green Lane building so that committee can utilize the technology available there to conference with the WKU staff.
- Next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, February 4th. At that time a report from each of the 3 subcommittees will be provided. OFI discussions will be held as well.
